## Part #1 Scales

Please play three scales:

- (a) 2-octave chromatic scale, all slurred, starting on any note
- (b) B-flat concert scale, 2 octaves if possible, slur-2/tongue-2 pattern

(c) An F major concert scale, your choice for speed and articulation
